Transport Month Activities

Welcome to Transport Month 2010 hosted by the City of Joburg in partnership with key stakeholders and others spheres of government.

Our focus areas are:

Community Leaders Seminar

There will be Community Leaders Seminars in each of the seven regions of the City where community leaders including councillors, ward committee members, community based organizations, public transport operators and local media will be invited to engage on how working together we can do more to improve road safety, our road infrastructure and public transport.

These seminars will be facilitated by the MMC for Transport, Rehana Moosajee and will include:

- Testimonies from people who have been impacted upon by the lack of road safety and discussion on how road safety can be improved;
- Public transport operators and commuters giving their respective views on public transport challenges; and.
- Community members being engaged to discuss what they can do to help protect our roads, storm water and public transport infrastructure.

School Road Safety Programme

In partnership with the JMPD and a primary schools per region, learners will take part in a pedestrian safety awareness campaign. In partnership with community based industrial theatre groups, performances will be arranged for three high schools per region followed by debates. The focus of the industrial theatre will include alcohol and drug abuse, drag racing, etc.
